






Three-Pronged Approach to HP2030 Development

Two HP2030-related Subgroups:

- Purpose: Begin development of Healthy People 2030
- Review nominations, propose member roster for Advisory Committee
- Develop draft charge to the Advisory Committee
- Propose Vision, Mission, Overarching Goals
- Propose objective selection criteria





FIW HP2030 Subgroup on Vision, Mission, Overarching Goals



- Created to provide input to the FIW HP2030 Subgroup and the FIW regarding the HP2030 Framework (Vision, Mission, and Overall Goals)
- Initial assessment is that the HP2020 Framework is a solid starting point for building the HP2030 Framework
- Subgroup has developed preliminary concepts for HP2030 Vision, Mission, Overarching Goals
- FIW continues to consider the subgroup's proposals and plans to incorporate their input through the public comment process with the Advisory Committee




